

IBIZA SPRINGBREAK 2026

ABOUT TRIP PREPARATIONS:

1. What do I need to bring?

Pack the essentials: ID card or passport, driver's license if you want to rent a car, health insurance card if you have one, and some cash.

Bring light clothing, swimsuits, comfortable shoes, flip-flops, sunglasses, a cap or hat, and a sweatshirt for the evenings. Don't forget sunscreen, toiletries, a beach towel, phone charger, power bank, and a small backpack for excursion days.

For our themed parties, check the dress code to make sure you bring everything you need!

ABOUT THE TRIP:

1. Will I have to leave a security deposit?

Yes. On the first day, the staff will request a €50 cash deposit per person as a guarantee for any potential damage to the hotel.

This amount will be fully refunded at the end of your stay, provided no damage has occurred.

2. Do I have to bring all my luggage with me on the ferry?

No, it's not necessary. The bus that took you to the Port of Valencia will board the ferry with us. However, anything left on the bus cannot be accessed until we arrive in Ibiza.

In any case, check with your tour leader as restrictions may change each year.

3. Will we have cabins on the ferry?

No. There will be no cabins on either the Valencia/Barcelona to Ibiza ferry or the Ibiza to Valencia/Barcelona ferry.

You will have access to common areas with seats. On the Valencia to Ibiza ferry, you won't even want to rest because we'll be hosting an incredible party with one of our DJs.

4. Can we bring alcohol onto the ferry?

No, alcohol is not allowed on board. If you bring alcohol, you will need to leave it on the bus.

5. How many stars does the hotel have?

We will stay in a tourist-category hotel, which may range between 2 and 3 stars depending on availability and group size.

This means you will have the essentials to enjoy your trip: private bathroom, basic cleaning service, and breakfast included. A comfortable and functional place to rest between parties and excursions.

The main hotel will be azuLine Hotel Pacific.

Hotels may be subject to change.

6. Is breakfast included in the trip price?

Yes, the trip includes 3 full hotel breakfasts.

The only breakfast not included is on the first day, as we will have early check-in (early arrival), but it does not count as a full night's stay.

7. What time is breakfast served?

Generally between 8:00 AM and 10:30 AM, but it may vary.

8. Does the hotel provide shower gel and shampoo?

Yes, the hotel usually provides basic shower gel and shampoo. However, you can bring your own if you prefer.

9. Does the hotel provide towels?

The hotel usually provides at least one towel per person.

We recommend bringing an extra towel for the beach. Ask us closer to the trip to confirm!

10. What are the hotel rooms like?

Rooms are generally triple rooms. However, depending on availability, some guests may stay in double rooms.

If you want to guarantee a double room, we recommend purchasing the double room supplement, as triple rooms are assigned by default.

The third bed may be a sofa-bed or auxiliary mattress, slightly smaller than a standard bed but still comfortable.

Room allocation is generally random, although we try to assign same-gender room sharing whenever possible.

11. Can I book a single room?

Yes, you can request a single room at the time of booking, but it requires an additional supplement.

Single rooms are limited and subject to availability, so we recommend requesting early if you prefer more privacy.

12. Does the hotel have a gym?

No, but... there's nothing better than working out on the beach!

ABOUT THE EXCURSIONS:

1. What does the Formentera excursion include?

Our bus will pick us up at the hotel and take us to the Port of Ibiza, where we will take a ferry to Formentera. The ferry ride lasts between 30 minutes and 1 hour.

Once in Formentera, you have different options:

Rent a car, motorbike, or bike

Near the port you'll find rental options. This allows you to explore the island at your own pace, discover hidden coves, scenic viewpoints, and paradise beaches. Perfect if you want total freedom.

Enjoy free time and explore on foot

If you prefer to relax without renting anything, you can walk around the port area or head towards Ses Illetes beach on foot. Formentera is small, safe, and perfect for walking. You can discover beautiful spots, take photos, and enjoy nature.

Meet at Ses Illetes beach

We'll set a meeting point for anyone who wants to enjoy the beach together — sun, white sand, and turquoise waters. A perfect place to relax, swim, and have fun with other students.

Afterward, we will agree on a meeting time at the Port of Formentera to take the ferry back (30 minutes to 1 hour).

Upon arrival in Ibiza, our bus will take us back to the hotel.

We recommend bringing:

- ID or passport
- Driver's license if renting a car or motorbike
- Swimsuit already on or in your bag
- Beach towel
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Flip-flops or sandals and comfortable shoes
- Light, comfortable clothing
- A change of dry clothes
- Water, snacks, and food (you can also buy there)
- Cash or card
- Phone and power bank
- Small backpack or tote bag

2. What does the Cala Tarida excursion include?

The bus will take us from the hotel to the beach.

You can enjoy free time or join our staff at a meeting point where we'll have group activities and entertainment.

We will set a return time and location for the bus back to the hotel.

3. What does the Dalt Vila excursion include?

The bus will take us to the Port of Ibiza. A local guide will meet us there for an approximately 1 hour and 30-minute tour of Ibiza's historic center.

After the tour, you'll have free time to explore.

We'll agree on a meeting point and time for the bus to take us back to the hotel.

ABOUT THE PARTIES:

1. Does the trip include parties?

Of course!

We start with a party on board the Valencia to Ibiza ferry (*the Barcelona ferry does not include the onboard party). Expect a DJ and an amazing atmosphere while sailing toward the island.

Once in Ibiza, after some rest, we'll welcome you with a hotel pool party — the perfect icebreaker and preview of what's coming.

Every night in Ibiza, we'll attend a different themed party at some of the island's top clubs. Each night is unique.

So yes — bring your energy... because this is going to be crazy (in the best way)!

2. Are transfers to the parties included?

Yes, transfers are included when necessary — meaning when the club is too far to walk from the hotel.

We organize transportation to the party venue.

Return transport is usually not included, as party ending times vary. However, we will always give you safe recommendations on how to get back to the hotel.

3. Do parties include drinks?

By default, drinks are not included unless specifically stated in the event details.

Entry to the clubs is included in the trip, but drinks must be purchased separately.
